This regatta shall be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing as modified by the San Francisco Express 27 class association.

Entry is open to yachts eligible to race in the Express 27 one-design class. Competitors may enter by mailing the entry form below to: Jeff Zarwell, RegattaPRO, 3001 Bridgeway Blvd., Ste K-249, Sausalito, CA 94965. Entry fee is \$80.00 if entered at the website below or postmarked by Saturday July 12th. Entries received after July 12th, are subject to a \$10 late fee.

The intended racing area will be the Berkeley Circle area with windward/ leeward courses set up using inflatable marks.

The first Warning Gun each day will be at 1200 hrs. Warning Gun for each succeeding race will be made as soon as practically possible. No warning shall be made after 1530 hrs.

The low point scoring system RRS A4 shall be used. Six races are scheduled. If more than four races are completed, a yacht's worst race score shall be discarded. A minimum of one race shall be completed to constitute a series.
